(EN) Bosnia and Herzegovina was a part of the Roman province Dalmatia. The Keys to Rome exhibition in Sarajevo will be built around the remains from the Roman period in Cim near Mostar and Ilidža near Sarajevo. Interactive virtual environments of the Early Christian basilica from Cim and Roman villa and thermal baths from Ilidža will be combined with physical exhibition of the remains from these sites kept in the National Museum of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Museum of Sarajevo. Sarajevo exhibition will take place in the recently restored building of the City Hall Vijecnica. It was initially the largest and most representative building of the Austro-Hungarian period in Sarajevo. This magnificent object was constructed in a mixture of styles combining historicism and pseudo-Moorish styles. The hexagonal space of the main aula will accommodate the exhibits and adjoining digital setups, during the first month of the exhibition, while they will be moved in the Sarajevo Museum until the closing of the exhibition.
